As they walked through the forest, they saw all kinds of animals: birds singing in the trees, rabbits hopping through the bushes, and deer running through the fields.



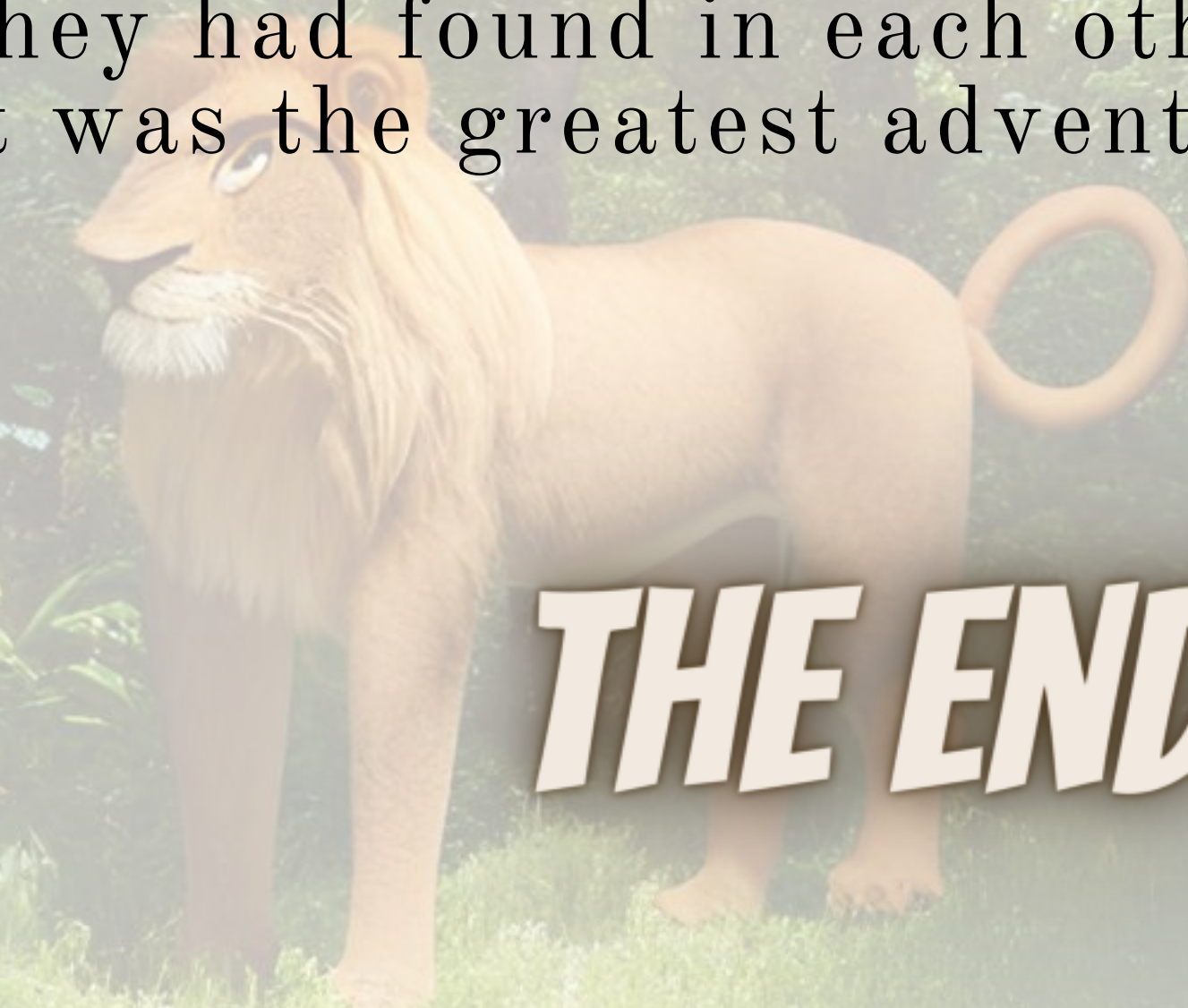

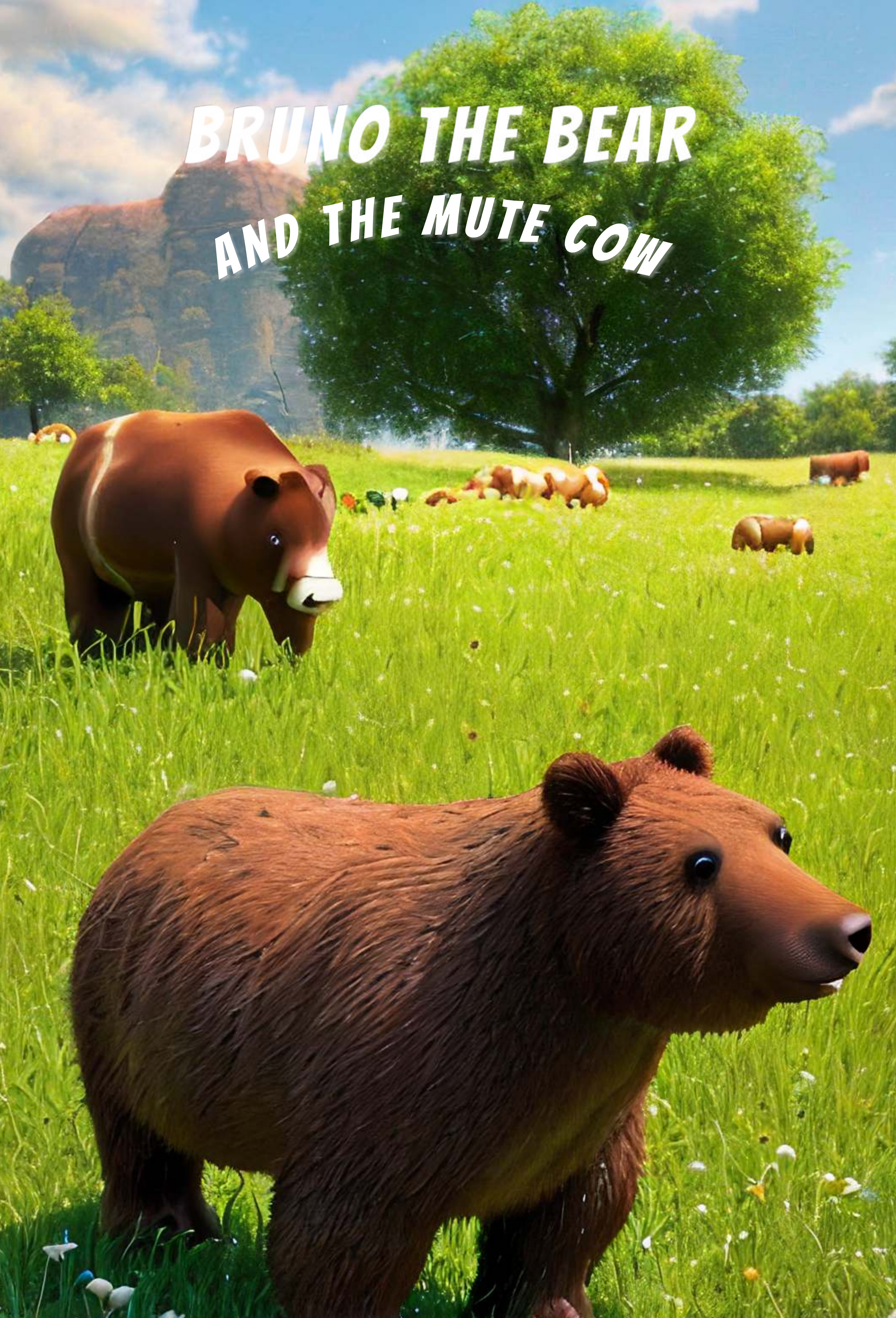
Despite their many achievements, Bruno and Leo never forgot the importance of friendship and always made time for each other. They were always there for each other, through the good times and the bad.

Once upon a time, in a beautiful forest, there lived a bear named Bruno. Bruno was a friendly bear who loved to play and explore the forest.




"I am Bella," said one butterfly.

He gently pried the bird's foot free and picked it up, cradling it in his big, soft paw. The bird chirped and fluttered its wings, grateful to be free.


"What's your name?" Bruno asked the bird.
